Returning to School?

For an adult learner, often the hardest aspect of returning to school is taking the first step. But when you are ready Canadore College will welcome you with support and services to help you succeed.

You are considered an adult learner if you are 19 years of age or older. Academic upgrading will help you improve the reading, writing, math, science and computer skills needed to get into the job or college program of your choice. Canadore College provides placement assessments to help guide you through your upgrading.

You should apply if:

- You did not finish high school
- You finished high school but need to refresh your skills and knowledge
- You have been out of school for more than one year
- You want to improve your job opportunities
- You want to obtain admission requirements for a college program or apprenticeship training

Academic Upgrading (AU)

The Academic Upgrading (AU) Program allows adult learners to refresh and upgrade their skills in math, English, and computer applications at an introductory level. Learners can improve their readiness for employment and/or prepare for other training opportunities. Many AU students proceed directly into the ACE Program.

Academic and Career Entrance Program (ACE)

The ACE Program provides adult learners with the opportunity to upgrade their academic skills with a particular focus on preparation for college programs or apprenticeship training. Depending on the learner's goal, studies may include math, English, sciences, computer applications and self-management. Successful completion of the ACE Program provides a grade 12 equivalence that is recognized for admission to college programs and apprenticeship training in Ontario.

Together, the Academic Upgrading Program and the Academic and Career Entrance Program can help you to assess your skills, clarify your goals, and prepare for further education.

- Ontario residents 19 years of age and older

- Proficient in English (speaking and listening)
- Able to work independently in a classroom setting
